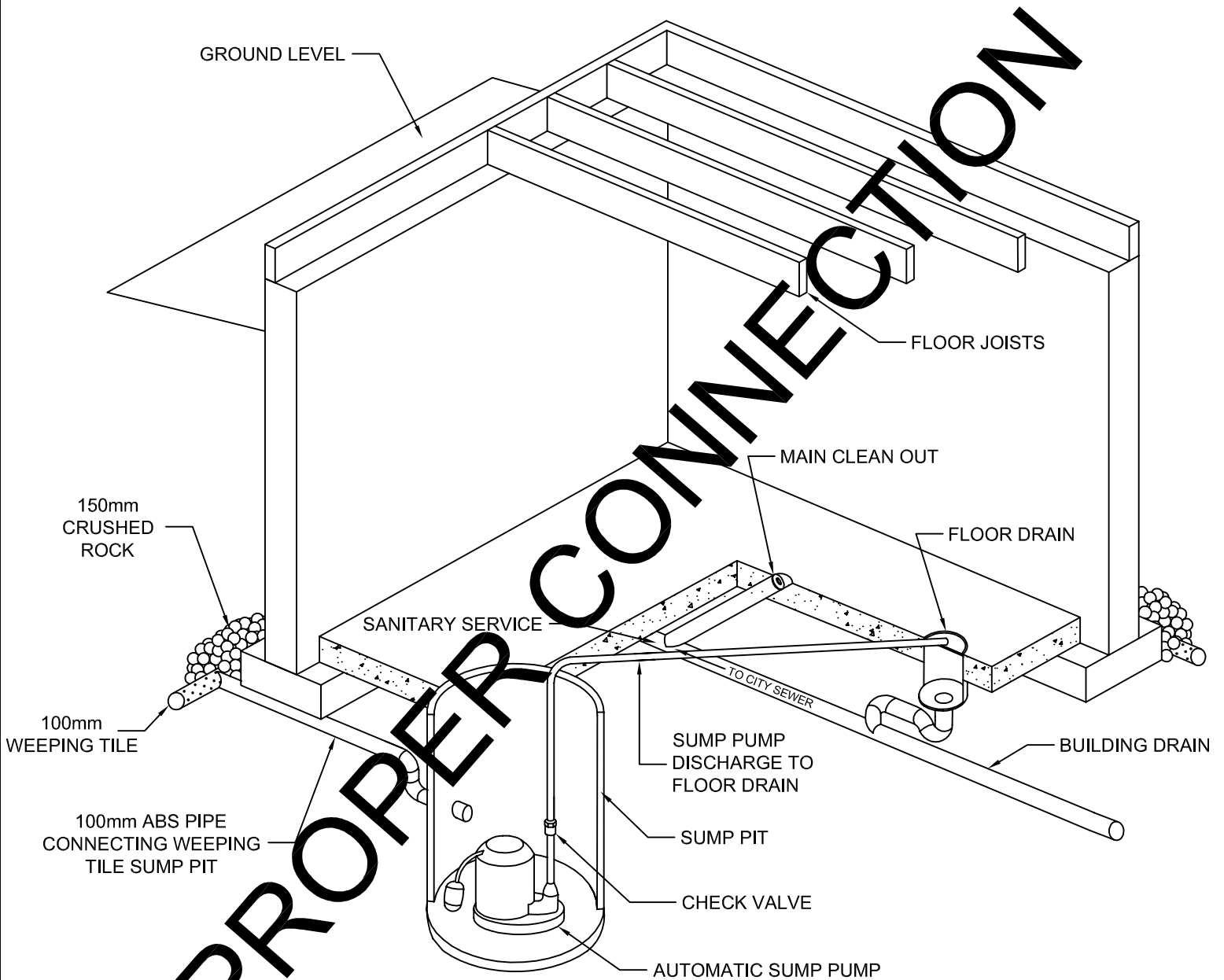


IMPROPER SUMP PUMP TO SANITARY SEWER DISCHARGE

Sump Pumps connecting to sewer services allow large amounts of storm water (entering from the weeping tile) to enter into the city's sanitary sewer mains. During heavy rain storm events, this can contribute to the surcharging of the city's sewer system.

Remedies include removing the existing sump pump discharge pipe from the floor drain, and installing a proper 38mm ABS (or equivalent) pipe to the outside lawn area.
