A letter must be forwarded to City Hall no less than 10 days prior to the planned party, stating the following information:

- a) Date and time of party.
- b) Exact location of street closure giving streets, avenues, or crescents affected.
- c) Signatures of over 50 percent of the residents affected by the closure of streets, agreeing to the closure for the party.
- d) State whether a loudspeaker permit is required.

Upon receiving the above information, the City shall approve the block party provided that:

- a) No letter has been received from at least one resident stating that they are against holding the party or having the street closed.
- b) No intersecting street is to be closed.
- c) Barricades can be picked up at the Works and Utilities Workshop and must be returned in good condition after the block party. Any damages to the barricades will be charged to the person picking them up.
- d) Further, all block parties are to end no later than 12:00 Midnight.
