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Visiting aircraft staying less than one week are exempt from Parking and Usage Fees. All other aircraft will be subject to Parking and Usage Fees at the Humboldt Airport.

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### Parking and Usage Fees:

(Without City Power)	Monthly	\$60.00 per plane

Aerial Applicators	Annual	\$750.00 per plane

\* The Rural Municipality of Humboldt has agreed to not charge taxes on hangars, however, consideration has been made in the Hangar Lot Lease Fee's in-lieu of Taxes for a direct financial contribution to the airport.

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\*\* Weight and location of the fuel truck will be at the discretion of the City to prevent damage to the grounds, apron and Taxi-ways. All liability is borne by owner of fuel truck.

# **Lot Leases for Hangars**

- Lots west of the east taxi-way are to be leased on a first come, first serve basis. After the west lots are fully occupied, the lots east of the west taxiway are to be leased on the same basis.
- 2. Hangars constructed on leased lots shall provide a two-foot side yard.
- 3. Hangars constructed on leased lots shall have no front yard. All hangars must be constructed on the front lot line in order to provide uniformity.

### **Volunteer Credit**

In acknowledgement of volunteer efforts from local pilots at the airport who have hangars and/or aircraft annually, the City will grant "volunteer credit" towards hangar, parking and usage fees for the following year. Valid volunteer credit consists of time dedicated to the general well-being of the airport. Valid volunteer time is to the discretion of the Works and Utilities Manager and shall be submitted on a monthly basis. Eligible volunteer credit is as follows:

- 1. Mowing, general cleanup and maintenance \$10.00 per hour
- 2. Fueling Visiting Aircraft \$20.00 for each fueling
- 3. Winter Runway Condition Reports (by City request) \$40.00 for each time
