## Bylaws

### BYLAW NO. 06/2022

- An amendment to Bylaw No. 06/2022 was proposed recommending that waste and recycling fees be increased from \$15.00/month to \$20.50/month. Council approved the amendment which will take effect for October and will appear on the October 14<sup>th</sup> utility bill.

## New Business

### PROCLAMATIONS

- Mayor Behiel proclaimed October as Agriculture Month. Citizens of Humboldt are encouraged to celebrate the people along the agricultural value chain who deliver healthy, affordable, safer products in a sustainable manner every day.

## New Business Cont'd.

### COMMUNITY AND LEISURE SERVICES

- Council approved the recommendation that the City purchase assets related to the Historical Campground and Mini Golf course so that the assets remain in the campground and serve future campers.

### PUBLIC WORKS

- Council approved the recommendation that the City pay \$195,912 to REACT to conclude payment disputes from 2020, 2021, and 2022.
- Council approved the recommendation that City Council authorize administration to apply to the Natural Infrastructure Fund of the Carl Schenn Park Detention Pond Project which is valued at \$1,535,000.
- Council approved the recommendation that City Council support the Urban Highways Connector Program Expression of Interest application to the Ministry of Highways for 70% of the Highway 20 railway crossing replacement, 100% of Kruse Road & Andreason Road repaving, and Highway 20 between 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
