City administration along with a volunteer attended a second Community and Career Fair on November 1, 2022 in Regina with the intent and purpose of aiding displaced Ukrainians. Information on housing, available jobs within the community and surrounding area, and other community information was provided. The City has aided one displaced Ukrainian settle within the community on November 7th where furniture and household essentials were provided that were donated by the community.

A transit service study has commenced with initial information, stakeholder names, and Mobility Van data being provided to the consultants conducting the study. The next phase will involve a community survey regarding the City's transportation needs which will be posted on the City's website, and paper copies will be available at City Hall.
