Bylaws

PUBLIC WORKS

• Council approved the amendment to the Water and Sewer Bylaw No. 10/2021 that will increase water and sewer rates by 3%. This additional revenue will be utilized to help fund the wastewater treatment upgrades (lagoon) as well as address operational and maintenance inflation. The new rates will come into effect January 1st, 2023.

Bylaws Cont'd

PUBLIC WORKS

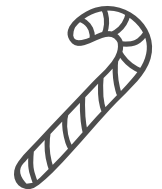
• Council approved the rate changes to the Storm Water Management Bylaw No. 08/2017 that will help fund projects relating to the better distribution of storm water and benefit user groups.

These fees fund large capital storm water detention ponds projects, storm water improvements, and historical loan payments. The funds have also been used to increase pumping capacity at lift stations during heavy rainfall events and wet seasons, fund watershed association fees, and the "Sump Pump Rebate" programs the City offers.

These rate changes will primarily effect multi-residential units and some businesses. Residential home owners will not see a change.
