**AND WHEREAS**, thousands from all over the globe came forward to support our families, our community and each other in unimaginable ways;

**AND WHEREAS**, each of those 29 involved in the tragedy have inspired legacies that will be cherished and will always have a place in our hearts;

**AND WHEREAS**, April 6<sup>th</sup>, 2024, will be the 6<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the tragedy;

**NOW THEREFORE:** I, Michael Behiel, Mayor of the City of Humboldt do hereby proclaim Saturday, April 6, 2024, as “**2017-18 Humboldt Broncos Day**” in the City of Humboldt and encourage all citizens to remember and honor those who were affected by the tragedy of April 6, 2018, and to observe a moment of silence at 4:50 pm, the approximate time the tragedy occurred 6 years ago;
