**Humboldt Pride Week:** Mayor Behiel has proclaimed the week of June 19th to June 25th as "Humboldt Pride Week" in the City of Humboldt to celebrate diversity.

Pride is a global movement that stands for equality and celebrates the diversity of lesbian, gay, bisexual, trans, intersex, queer, questioning, two-spirited and their allies. 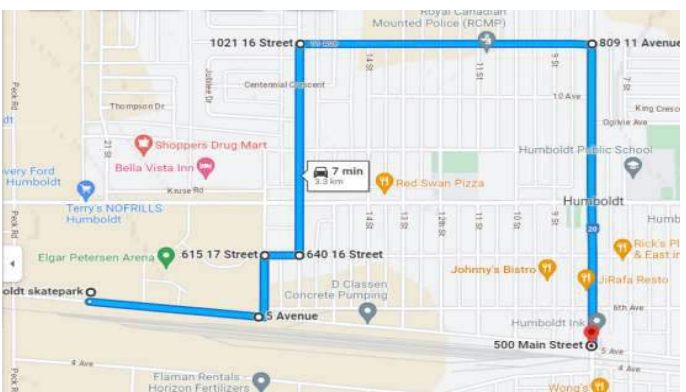
#### JULY 1ST FIREWORKS DISPLAY

The City will have a spectacular fireworks show at Centennial Park on July 1, 2023 at dusk. To ensure the safety of all spectators and the team hired to set off the fireworks, Council approved Leisure Services request that 5th Avenue, from 17th Street to Peck Road be closed off to traffic from 8:30pm to 11:00pm. Spectators will have access to the Uniplex grounds from 17th Street and the Highway 5 entrance or may opt to park in one of the surrounding parking lots.
