Special Meeting of Council

DECISIONS ON REQUESTS FOR PROPOSALS

A Special Meeting of Council was held on Monday, July 10 to discuss the results of a Tender and a Request for Proposal for 2 projects; one for the Convention Centre Washrooms Renovation and another for modifications to the roof of the library.

At the time of closing the tender for the Convention Centre Washrooms Renovations process, the City had received bids that were all well over budget. Because of this, Council decided that it is in the best interest of the City not to proceed with offering any contract at this time.

In addition, the sole bid received for the library roof modifications was not accepted due to it being over budget.

It is important that Council and Administration be prudent and not to simply accept bids and quotes with inflated prices, but to ensure that all avenues available be explored to ensure the best use of municipal funds.

Administration is committed to making necessary upgrades to our existing facilities, however it is imperative that we are confident that the funds being invested in our facilities are appropriate.

"HAF" Application and Proposed Residential Construction Incentive Bylaw

CMHC has recently announced a Housing Accelerator Fund ("HAF"), a \$4 billion initiative that will provide funding to cities, towns, and Indigenous governments to develop innovative measures to unlock new housing supply and fast-track the creation of 100,000 new homes across Canada.

Administration is currently working on an application for this funding for the City of Humboldt. In addition, a proposed Bylaw for an incentive program to "kick-start" residential construction in Humboldt is being drafted.

The proposed incentive program is meant to apply to all new residential construction permits that are taken out in Humboldt from January 1st, 2023 to September 1st, 2026. This period of time aligns with both the HAF funding period and with the anticipated population growth in Humboldt.

Council will discuss the Bylaw at the next Regular Meeting of Council on Monday, July 24, 2023.
