



# humboldt's



The City of Humboldt is named after Baron Alexander von Humboldt, a world famous German scientist and naturalist, who traveled extensively in Central and South America. The name Humboldt was approved in 1875 for the site in the Northwest Territories along the Canadian Pacific Telegraph Line at which a repair station was built. The station played an integral part in communications for the developing west and in the M@tis Resistance of 1885 at Batoche. With the increasing development of western Canada, settlers were arriving in the area at the turn of the century. The history of Humboldt was influenced by the establishment of St. Peter s Colony by the Benedictine monks. The name Humboldt was transferred to the village in 1905 and it became a town in 1907. Humboldt became Saskatchewan s thirteenth city in November 2000.


