Humboldt Golf Club ("HGC")

Board members expressed their appreciation of the Governance Committee appointed by Council in early 2023 and the good work that his been done. In May of 2023, the City made an agreement with the HGC that the City would provide \$100,000 in shortfall funding upon certain conditions being met by the end of the year. With these conditions now met, the funding will be provided and ensures that the golf course will open this spring. The additional funding that was recommended in November is no longer required. The HGC conveyed their interest in continuing to work with the Governance Committee while they search for a long term solution.

NEW WATER METERS PURCHASE APPROVED

Council approved Administration's recommendation to order approximately 457 water meters valued at \$200,000 due to many meters that were installed between 2004 and 2008 failing prior to the 20-year warranties. The manufacturer has agreed to supply replacement meters at a discounted price of approximately 40% off to address the failures and resolve staff concerns. The newer design appears to be more resilient and will come with full pro-rated warranty.
