PROCLAMATIONS

2017-18 Humboldt Broncos Day:

On April 6, 2018, the Humboldt Broncos Junior "A" Hockey Club was involved in a tragic bus collision on their way to a playoff game against the Nipawin Hawks, resulting in the heartbreaking loss of 16 people and will have an everlasting traumatic



effect on the 13 who survived, their families and our community.

Mayor Behiel has proclaimed Saturday, April 6, 2024, as "2017-18 Humboldt Broncos Day" and encourages all citizens to remember and honor those who were affected by the tragedy, and to observe a moment of silence at 4:50 pm, the approximate time the tragedy occurred 6 years ago.

Green Shirt Day: On April 6, 2018, the Humboldt Bronco organization, the Humboldt community and the world experienced unimaginable loss and suffering as a result of the Humboldt Bronco team bus tragedy.



On April 7, 2018, Bronco player Logan Boulet succumbed to his injuries and upon doing so, his parents, Bernadine and Toby Boulet chose to fulfill Logan's wishes and donate his organs so that six lives could be saved.

This selfless act inspired over 100,000 Canadians to become organ donors in the days and weeks that followed which resulted in the largest number of Canadians to register as organ donors in Canadian history due to one event – one person - which has now become known as the "Logan Boulet Effect".

Mayor Behiel has proclaimed Sunday, April 7, 2024 as "Green Shirt Day" in the City of Humboldt to raise awareness of the importance of organ donation and to encourage citizens to "have the kitchen table talk" with their families and to wear green on this day to show your support.

Streetfest Closure Request

Following a request to Council at the February 26th Regular Council Meeting, the matter to close Main Street was referred back to Administration. This led to a discussion with the Business Improvement District ("BID") with a recommendation to include the 500 Block of Main Street for the event. The new proposal was presented to Council on March 25 with the recommendation, which Council approved. Main Street will be blocked off from 8th Avenue (Hwy 5) to the North side of 5th Avenue. 7th Avenue and Main Street intersection will be blocked off on the east and west sides of Main Street near the closest alley. 6th Avenue and Main Street intersection will be blocked off on the east and west sides of Main Street near the closest alley. Access to the alleys, parking lots and street parking would continue to be allowed on both 7th & 6th Avenues. Streetfest is scheduled for all day Friday, August 23rd and all Saturday, August 24th!
