Highlights from the Regular Meeting of Council held on Monday, April 22, 2024

Public Hearing

A Public Hearing was held to amend Bylaw 05/2022, a Bylaw to guarantee the repayment of a loan held by Conexus Credit Union and Issued to Humboldt Golf Club Inc. The Bylaw was originally signed in 2022. The Bylaw amendment is required to recognize the change in terms and interest rate. As per the *Cities Act*, Division 8 Loans & Guarantees, the City must issue a bylaw when a guarantee is provided by a city to a non-profit organization, such as the Humboldt Golf Club. The loan is to provide financing for the construction of the Events Centre. The City supported the construction project by issuing a 5-yr short term loan of \$150,000, the issuance of Official Donation Receipts for Income Tax Purposes, and by guaranteeing a 20-year loan for \$230,522.

Bylaws

Bylaw No. 03/2024: 2024 Taxation Rate Bylaw

Council passed Bylaw No. 03/2024, which allows for the approval of property tax rates for the 2024 year. This Bylaw will allow for an estimated tax increase of approximately 4.58% in 2024.

City Council approved the Downtown BID's budget as presented.

Humboldt & District Community Services Parking Pass Request:

The Humboldt & District Community Services made a request to City Council to exempt the cost of 6 parking passes for the summer months. These passes will be used by their summer students that are hired to run their Summer Program.

The City has sponsored Humboldt & District Community Services with parking passes in the past and once again have approved the request for 2024.
