DELEGATIONS

At a Special Meeting of Council held Monday, June 9th, MNP provided the 2024 Audited Financial Statements which will be posted on the City's website in the near future.

BYLAWS

City Council passed Bylaw 13/2025, A bylaw to amend Bylaw 10/2025 to include dimensions of land to be sold. On April 28, 2025, Council read bylaw 10/2025, a bylaw to authorize the sale of municipal reserve land.

City Council also gave the first reading of Bylaw 14/2025 - 10th Street Closure. As part of the creation of the 14th Avenue right-of-way, the undeveloped 10th Street right-of-way will be closed. Closing a street requires consent from the Ministry of Highways as well as a bylaw approved by Council.

The subdivision will create a right-of-way f 14th Avenue from the existing 14th Avenue right-of-way to the expected location of the future 16th Street.
