## Special Meeting of Council

At a Special Meeting of Council held Monday, September 8, Council gave the first reading of Bylaw 16/2025, a bylaw to amend Bylaw 03/2016 known as the Official Community Plan. Currently, the land in question is designated as Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces on the OCP Future Land Use Map. However, the City of Humboldt adopted Bylaw No. 08/2024 to rezone to a portion of the parcel in 2024 to accommodate residential development, and an accompanying OCP amendment was not completed at that time to ensure alignment between the two bylaws. A public hearing on the proposed bylaw amendment will take place at the September 22nd Regular Council Meeting.

Council approved the annual installation of Legion Veteran Banners on City streetlight poles in support of the Royal Canadian Legion Branch #28 - Humboldt.

Council approved the recommendation to engage a qualified consultant to collect traffic volume data along major transportation corridors.

## Public Works

### Road Maintenance:

- Sand slurry seal work has been completed for the season.
- Paving contractors will finalize patch work city-wide by mid-September.

### Water & Sewer Infrastructure:

- Water main replacement is underway along 10th Street between 9th Ave and 11th Ave.
- Sewage lift stations #1 and #4 are currently under construction for upgrades.

**Wastewater Treatment Facility:** The new facility has begun accepting wastewater in the first cell. Remaining cells will be filled upon completion, and system circulation will commence to establish necessary bacterial colonies.
