Highlights from the Regular Meeting of Council held on Monday, November 24, 2025

PUBLIC HEARING

Two Public Hearings were held during the Regular Meeting of Council.

The first being in regard to a Discretionary Use Application to allow an "existing non-conforming" residential use to continue on a site with a proposed Automotive Sales business at 105680 8th Ave. No written submissions were received and no one was in attendance to speak to this issue.

The second Public Hearing was held in regard to a Discretionary Use application to operate a Construction Trade business at 107 Main Street. There were no written submissions received and no one was in attendance to speak to the issue.

DELEGATIONS

Jaz Boparai, Walnut Grove Developments

A presentation was made to Council with details on the history of Walnut Grove Developments and its relationship with the City of Humboldt.

Council accepted the report for information and thanked Mr. Boparai for his presentation.

PUBLIC ACKNOWLEDGMENTS

Councillor Siermachesky acknowledged Mrs. Robyn Moore and her Grade 7 Class at Humboldt Public School for their 'No Stone Left Alone' service held on November 4th and 6th. A service was held and poppies were laid at the gravestones of all fallen veterans at both city cemetery's.

Councillor Rowe acknowledged the Royal Canadian Legion and everyone that took part in the Remembrance Day ceremony at St. Augustine Church. It was good to see so many people in attendance and the ceremony was very well done once again this year.

Mayor Muench reiterated his appreciation for the Remembrance Day ceremony and thanked Reverend Al Hingley for his many years of service with the Legion and putting on the annual ceremony for Remembrance Day.

Mayor Muench acknowledged the Saskatchewan Roughriders on their Grey Cup victory this year and everyone involved with the team's success.

NEW BUSINESS

Council approved the recommendation to award the tender for one 2026 Ford Explorer Interceptor at a cost of \$54,854.00 plus tax to Discovery Ford, and also authorized Administration to spend up to \$30,000 on the outfitting of the vehicle for enforcement purposes.

Council approved a Discretionary Use Application to allow an "existing non-conforming" residential use to continue for a 5 year term on a site with an Automotive Sales business at 105680 8th Ave.

Council approved a Discretionary Use Application to operate a Construction Trade at 107 Main Street legally described as Block/ Parcel 58 - Plan 102191543.

Council approved the Humboldt & District Museum and Gallery Permanent Art Collection Policy, Permanent Art Collection Gift Agreement, Art Curatorial Committee Terms of reference, and the revised Collections Management Terms of Reference, and the Gallery was approved as an eligible project to receive Official Donation Receipts from the City of Humboldt in 2025.

Council approved the recommendation to advise Community Planning that the City supports the approval of subdivision application SC-0128-25 resulting in the creation of 14 residential allotments, road allowance parcel and Municipal Reserve. The applicant, North Ridge Developments will be required to enter into a serving agreement with the City to ensure appropriate services and facilities that serve the subdivision..

Council approved the recommendation to award the Ice Resurfacers contract to Big Hill for the purchase of an Olympia Millennium Model H Side Dump at a cost of \$161,177.

Council approved the 2025 Design Standards Manual as presented by Administration. The City's Minimum Design standards were last updated in 2012. These standards govern the design of municipal services for new subdivisions, infill developments, and property redevelopment within the City of Humboldt.

Council approved the recommendation to decline the funding request from the Community Gathering Place for financial support toward their roof replacement project.

Council approved the recommendation to advise Community Planning that the City supports the approval of subdivision of Lot 48, Plan 99H00626. The subdivision approval will provide two new residential units to the City and is in line with both the zoning bylaw and OCP of the City.

NEW BUSINESS CONT.

Council approved the recommendation to advise Community Planning that it supports subdivision application SA253278, which will create 30 residential lots, a road allowance parcel, and a Municipal Reserve. The applicant, Bluestone Builders Group, will be required to enter into a servicing agreement with the City to ensure appropriate services for the development.

Council approved the proposed street name "Keystone Place" for the cul-de-sac in the new Bluestone Development subdivision.

BYLAWS

Council passed Bylaw 17/2025, a bylaw to amend Traffic Bylaw 05/2016. The amendment will allow signage installation for an accessibility parking stall. The stall will be located in front of the Good Neighbour Store at 239 Main Street. The amendment includes revisions to location descriptions in the bylaw.
