RECOMMENDATION

That the requested street blockade in the downtown from 5:00 to 9:00pm for a special event on November 20th, 2025 be approved as attached.

BACKGROUND

Pursuant to the City of Humboldt's Policy #4510, requests for a street blockaded are to be presented at a Regular Council meeting for approval. Prior to the request being brought to Council, Administration consults with City departments to ensure that the requested street closures would not conflict with any City maintenance or operations.

CURRENT SITUATION

The Downtown Business Improvement District (DBID) requested a street blockade for their Santa Clause parade in conjunction with the Moonlight Madness event.

The DBID is seeking temporary blockades of 5th Avenue from 7th Street to 9th Street, Main Street from 5th Avenue to 7th Avenue, and 9th Street from 5th Avenue to 7th Avenue. Further they have requested that a portion of 6th Avenue from Main Street east to the back alley be included for the hosting of additional activities during the parade.

The parade is planned to start at 6pm, will begin with the procession lined up along 5th Avenue facing west, they will proceed north up Main Street, turning west on 7th Avenue and then proceeding south down 9th Street before concluding on 5th Avenue.

OPTIONS

1. Approve the recommendation.
2. Reject the recommendation and not allow the street blockade.
