## Protective Services

**MIKE KWASNICA - FIRE CHIEF/DIRECTOR OF PROTECTIVE SERVICES**

**Community Safety Officer report:** There were 39 calls for service. CSO Ehalt spent 4 days in Lanigan, 4 days in Watson and 4 in Humboldt where he added 19 property visits and 17 bylaw warnings.

**RCMP report:** Reported incidents were down in November (120) as compared to last month (160), and up from November 2024(112).

**Planning & Development report:** In November, there were 3 permits issued and 15 inspections performed. The Planning Department is working on the South 40 structure plan and development, 101st Street subdivision, and the Caleb subdivision.

**Corporate Services:** Administration is preparing for the 2025 year-end, coordinating system updates and getting ready for the City's auditor's, who will conduct the interim audit on-site from December 17-19.

Following the passing of the 2026 budget, staff will proceed to calculate and implement the resulting increase for all monthly TIPPS program members, effective for the January withdrawal.

Staff is evaluating a Human Resources portal to potentially clean up payroll processes and create efficiencies.

**Outdoor rinks:** Parks staff have been actively working on ice installation at both the St. Dominic rink and the Jacob Leicht Outdoor Rink.

**Bill Brecht Park - seasonal outdoor rink:** With funding from the Sask. Lotteries Grant, the City provided temporary boards and access to water from the St. Dominic Rink standpipe. The neighborhood group who initiated the project will build and maintain the rink this winter.

**Uniplex Air Movement:** Administration identified that recent air quality and temperature fluctuations in the main lobby were caused by an air imbalance in the Aquatic Centre. Repairs and adjustments have been completed, and the issue appears to be resolved.
